The cover is of the beautiful, reconstructed Hurva Synagogue in the Old City of Jerusalem. Built in the 1700s, it was destroyed in 1721, rebuilt, and demolished again by the Jordanians in 1948. The dedication of the restored Hurva in 2010 heralds a revival of worship in Jewish Jerusalem. Arabs howled in anger, deeming Hurva's presence a threat to Islamic shrines on the Temple Mount. 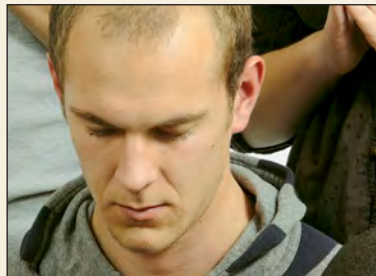
