

## TOUR ITINERARY\*\*

### DAY 1 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 24

We meet at Newark International Airport in New Jersey to begin our historic *Up to Jerusalem* 2019 journey. EL AL flight #LY26 departs at 9:15 p.m. and arrives in Israel Friday, October 25, at 2:40 p.m.

### DAY 2 – FRIDAY, OCTOBER 25

Upon arriving in Tel Aviv we will be welcomed by our Israeli tour guide and head straight to our hotel for dinner and a good night's sleep. Accommodations tonight are at the Dan Panorama Hotel in Tel Aviv, where we will enjoy our first Israeli dinner.



### DAY 3 – SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26

We begin our tour with a visit to the ancient port of Joppa, where Jonah fled from God and Peter received a vision from God to take the gospel to the Gentiles. Following lunch, we'll drive to the Ayalon Museum ammunition factory on Kibbutz Hill. The factory was established in 1946, and is now a tribute to the brave men and women who worked there in the most extreme conditions. Next we will make our way to the Valley of Elah, where David confronted the mighty giant Goliath.



### DAY 4 – SUNDAY, OCTOBER 27

We begin our second full day in Israel at Independence Hall, Tel Aviv, where David Ben Gurion read Israel's Declaration of Independence on the afternoon of May 14, 1948. From here we drive to the ancient Roman city of Caesarea Maritime, on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea. We will stand in the ancient amphitheater and remember men like Cornelius, Peter, Paul, and Pilate. After viewing the famous Roman aqueduct, we will continue north by way of Haifa to Mount Carmel where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal, and pass by a Second Temple Period tomb with rolling stone. We will visit Tel Megiddo, the site of biblical Armageddon and view from its summit the plain where the armies of the world will assemble for the last great battle of the Tribulation. Accommodations tonight are at Ramot Holiday Resort Kibbutz on the Sea of Galilee.



### DAY 5 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 28

After traveling north to the Lebanese border, we will meet with a representative of Kibbutz Misgav Am to learn about the challenges of life in this community located on the border with Lebanon. Our day will include a visit to Caesarea Philippi, which marks the headwaters of the Jordan River and the place of Peter's great confession of faith in Jesus Christ. We will continue to the Golan Heights and its 'capital,' Katzrin. Overlooking Syria, the Golan is one of Israel's most beautiful areas and most critical to its survival. We will then travel to the historic city of Gamla, also known as the "Masada of the North." Our day of touring will end as we follow our Lord's steps along the rim of the Galilee to the Mount of Beatitudes to share the reminders of the blessings bestowed on His servants. We'll stop to visit the ancient "Jesus Boat" and Galilee Boat Museum to visit their gift shop. Dinner tonight will be at the famous Lido Decks Restaurant on the waters of the Sea of Galilee.

### DAY 6 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 29

Our day will begin with a boat ride and devotions on the Sea of Galilee. Then we will stop to see the first-century synagogue in the ancient town of Magdala. After this we will plant trees as lasting memorials to loved ones and the land. Next, we will visit Nazareth Village and experience the reenactment of life at the time of Jesus, and enjoy a biblical lunch. From there we will go to Capernaum, the headquarters for Jesus' ministry from which He taught His disciples, and ministered to the people in the north.



### DAY 7 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 30

Our day will begin by visiting a picturesque stretch of the Jordan River for a baptism, where huge eucalyptus trees droop into the quiet water. We'll continue our journey traveling south along the Jordan Valley to the Dead Sea. Along the way, we will stop at the Qumran Caves, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found and then head further south for a cable car ride to the top of Masada. We'll hear how this ancient mountain top stands as a monument to Israel's continuing struggle for survival. We'll end our day by checking into the Daniel Dead Sea Hotel for a relaxing and enjoyable float on the Dead Sea and overnight accommodations.

### DAY 8 – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 31

Today we ascend "Up to Jerusalem" to the Mount of Olives for a spectacular view of the Temple Mount, where Jesus revealed Himself as the Messiah, followed by a visit to the Garden of Gethsemane. Next is the Yad Vashem Memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, a must-visit for all *Up to Jerusalem* tours. At Mount Herzl we will enjoy the interactive experience of the museum dedicated to Theodore Herzl, the visionary for the Jewish state. Afterward, we will check in to the Dan Panorama Hotel. This evening will include an after-dinner tour of the Western Wall Tunnel, the famous rabbinic tunnel that runs along Herod's ancient wall.

### DAY 9 – FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 1

Our seventh day in Israel begins with a visit to the Davidson Center. Here we will enter another world as the glass doors close behind you, and you view the city's glorious past, showcased through the prism of advanced visualization technology. We'll see the Temple Mount and visit the City of David. From here we continue on to the village of Bethlehem, the town where Jesus was born and visit the Shepherds' field. We will drive back to Jerusalem for sundown at the Western Wall to watch the various modern Jewish communities gather to usher in Shabbat, a unique and inspiring experience.

### DAY 10 – SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 2

We begin our day with a visit to the Friends of Zion Museum. A walking tour of the old city of Jerusalem will include a stop at naturally acoustic Saint Anne's church and a visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, one of the two possible sites where Christ was crucified. Our afternoon will conclude with a visit to Gordon's Calvary to see the other possible site of the crucifixion and partake in a memorable communion service at the Garden Tomb. For those who are interested, Saturday evening will afford an opportunity for a walk to the popular Ben Yehuda Street to shop.



### DAY 11 – SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 3

Today our stops will take us through the newer area of the city of Jerusalem. We will visit the Knesset, Israel's single chamber parliament, where democracy in action reflects the spirit, opinions, and diversity of the State of Israel. Next we will see the dome-like Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept and see the model of Jerusalem at the time of Christ. We'll also visit the Bible Lands Museum to explore the culture of the ancient peoples of the Bible. Our *Up to Jerusalem* tour will conclude this evening with a farewell dinner and address by a prominent Israeli official.

### DAY 12 – MONDAY, NOVEMBER 4

We will travel to Ben Gurion International Airport for our flight back to Newark. EL AL flight #LY27 departs at 1:00 a.m. and arrives in Newark at 6:20 a.m.
