It is a highlight of the summer and you are invited to join us, The Friends of Israel, for our annual bus trip to the Christians United for Israel's "Night to Honor Israel" program on Monday, July 8, 2019, from 7:30 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. at the Washington, DC, Convention Center (801 Mt. Vernon Place NW, Washington, DC 20001).

Many Jewish friends will be joining thousands of Christians to celebrate Israel and stand together with the Jewish state. The program is always a thrilling experience, and this year promises to be no different. Israel's dynamic Prime Minister, Benjamin Netanyahu, is scheduled to speak via satellite, as well as Israel's ambassador to the United States, David Friedman, in person. The price is \$50 per person, payable when you register, which includes both the program and bus transportation to and from Washington, DC. Due to the security for the event, when tickets are purchased we must collect names to attach to each ticket.

We will be gathering by 1:30 p.m. at The Friends of Israel (FOI) headquarters located at 1179 Almonesson Road, Westville, NJ 08093. The bus will depart from FOI promptly at 1:45 p.m. We will be making a food court stop en route to Washington, DC. The bus will return to FOI following the event. One of the best experiences of this trip is the fellowship among Christians and Jewish friends who ride the FOI bus together.
